



Dragon Squash Cup 2024 Tournament Regulations

Definitions:

Tournament - the sports event, a competition called Dragon Squash Cup, organised by the Dragon Balls Kraków Sports Club, called the Organiser (with its registered office at ul. Czyżówka 43, 30-526 Kraków, NIP number 6793263624) operating in the form of an association.

Organising Committee - Squash Section of the Dragon Balls Kraków Sports Club and persons designated by the Management Board.

Player - a participant, a person registered for the Tournament via the registration form.

Registration form - a panel on the Dragon Balls Kraków Sports Club website located under a specific link to register Players who want to participate in the Tournament.

A. GENERAL RULES

- 1. The Tournament is organised by the Squash Section of the Dragon Balls Kraków Sports Club (with its registered office at ul. Czyżówka 43, 30-526 Kraków, NIP number 6793263624) operating in the form of an association whose statute does not provide for running a business, registered by the Krakow City Hall.
- 2. The Tournament aims to create a friendly and sporty atmosphere, promote Squash and enable players from Poland and abroad to compete with each other.
- 3. The Tournament will take place on October 5, 2024 in Krakow.
- 4. The Tournament location: Racquet Squash Club SCU Krzanik, J. Krzanik based at ul. Rzemieślnicza 20F in Kraków.
- 5. The Organiser reserves the right to change the location of the Tournament in case the number of participants significantly affects the rental price, and thus, the price of participation in the Tournament. Such information will be announced 14 days before the start of the Tournament. Information will be made available on the Tournament website at https://www.dragonballs.pl/squash-cup.
- 6. The Organiser has appointed an Organising Committee which, on its behalf, will supervise the proper organisation and course of the Tournament.
- 7. The Organiser reserves the right to limit the number of participants.

- 8. Players are obliged to comply with these regulations. The Player accepts the regulations on their behalf by sending the Registration Form.
- 9. Only people who have registered via the Registration Form available at the link can take part in the Tournament https://www.dragonballs.pl/squash-cup.
- 10. Registration remains valid after payment of the tournament fee (see par. B. TOURNAMENT FEES).
- 11. The Player's registration is confirmed by sending the tournament fee (see par. B. TOURNAMENT FEES) and may be cancelled by the Player, but the funds are not refundable unless the Tournament is cancelled by the Organiser. Following the statute, unused funds from the payment made to the account of the Dragon Balls Kraków Sports Club will be allocated to the club's statutory activities
- 12. The Tournament registration is open until September 21, 2024.

B. TOURNAMENT FEES

- 1. The Tournament Organiser sets increasing fees depending on the period in which the Player's registration will be completed.
- 2. The Organiser establishes the following stages of registration:

STAGE I: PLN 110 or EUR 30 per person in the period from August 12 to 31, 2024;

STAGE II: PLN 130 or EUR 40 per person in the period from September 1 to September 21, 2024;

If the Player holds a partnership card (Benefit Multisport, FitProfit, Medicover Sport, PZU Sport), **PLN 30 may be deducted from the fee.**

3. The tournament fee should be paid to the account number indicated below and enter the data provided below:

- 4. The Player's registration is valid only after making a payment in the amount applicable in a given period of each stage, the date of receipt of the funds to the Organiser's account is decisive. Failure to make a payment or making an incomplete payment within 7 days of sending the Registration Form will result in the cancellation of the submitted Registration Form.
- 5. The tournament fee includes: a welcome package, participation in the Tournament, snacks and drinks (on the day of the Tournament), prizes for Players who take 1st, 2nd and 3rd places at all levels, respectively, and an entry ticket to the post-tournament event in the place designated by the Organiser.

- 6. The tournament fee does not include costs related to possible accommodation or expenses incurred on means of transport and other costs not described in point. 5 B. TOURNAMENT FEES.
- 7. The Organiser does not insure any Players against accidents for the duration of the Tournament. Players may purchase appropriate insurance on their own and at their own expense.

C. PLAYERS' OBLIGATIONS

- 1. People with no health contraindications to actively practising sports can participate in the Tournament.
- 2. Each Player is obliged to follow the judges' recommendations strictly.
- 3. Each Player is required to wear sports clothes and Squash-appropriate indoor footwear.
- 4. Players must be over 18 years of age.
- 5. Players must comply with the provisions contained in organisational announcements and given during the technical briefing as well as other provisions regarding, among others, the organisation of facilities, locker rooms, separate areas, organisation of opening and closing ceremonies of Tournaments and announcement of results.
- 6. It is strictly forbidden to consume alcohol during the Tournament.
- 7. The Organiser is not responsible for items left or lost in the sports facility where the Tournament is held.
- 8. Players are obliged to read <u>the regulations of the sports facility</u> where the Tournament is held and to comply with these regulations. Lack of knowledge of the regulations does not release the Player taking part in the Tournament from liability resulting from failure to comply with these regulations.
- 9. Players who do not comply with the provisions of these regulations may be excluded from the Tournament. The Organising Committee decides on exclusion.

D. TOURNAMENT RULES AND PLAY SYSTEM

- 1. Dragon Squash Cup 2024 is a tournament in which we compete individually for each place in three categories: "Rising Stars" (Beginner Level), "Court Challengers" (Intermediate Level), "Elite Masters" (Advanced Level) and for the Dragon Squash Cup. 2024.
- 2. Players' game levels:
 - a. "Rising Stars" (Beginner Level) This level is intended for players who are just starting their adventure with Squash or have little experience in the game. Players at this level are usually familiar with the game's basic rules. However, their technique, fitness and strategy are still under development. "Rising Stars" players focus on

- improving basic skills, such as correct posture, basic strokes and orientation on the court.
- b. "Court Challengers" (Intermediate Level) Intermediate-level players have a solid technical foundation and demonstrate good court orientation. They already have experience in tournament competition and can use more advanced strategies while playing. At this level, "Court Challengers" can successfully use a variety of shots and their game is characterised by more significant control over tempo and tactics. Players work on developing endurance, agility and precision in the game.
- c. "Elite Masters" (Advanced Level) Advanced players have extensive experience and skills in Squash. Their techniques are very high, and they can precisely control the ball and use advanced tactics. Players at this level compete at the highest level, often participating in tournaments, and have a deep knowledge of the game and the ability to adapt to their opponent's style quickly.
- 3. Suppose an insufficient number of participants register for a given level. In that case, the levels will be combined as follows: "Rising Stars" with "Court Challengers" or "Elite Masters" with "Court Challengers".
- 4. The official Squash rules hold all matches.
- 5. Players are obliged to comply with the principle of sports competition "fair play", respecting rivals and judges.
- 6. Matches are played in the 'Best of 3' system (up to 2 sets won).
- 7. We play each set to 11 points; in case of 10-10, we play to a 2-point advantage.
- 8. Ball of the Tournament: 2 yellow dots.
- 9. Players take part in the Tournament at their own risk.
- 10. The Organiser is not responsible for any damage, injuries or property loss of participants.
- 11. Detailed Tournament rules and the competition system will be available to Players **no later than September 28, 2024**).

F. PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

- 1. Following the Regulation of the European Parliament and of the EU Council 2016/679 of April 27, 2016, we would like to inform you that the administrator obtaining personal data is the Dragon Balls Kraków Sports Club with its registered office in Kraków 30-526, ul. Czyżówka 43. Contact with the administrators is possible via email at dragonballskrakow@gmail.com.
- 2. The purpose of processing personal data is to organise the Tournament. The basis for the processing of Players' data is their consent to the processing of personal data at the time of sending the Registration Form.

- 3. The personal data obtained include email address, telephone number, name, surname, and the image of participants recorded in photographs or films from the Tournament where the Player took part. In exceptional cases and to organise other activities, administrators may ask Players to provide other data, such as full name and other data necessary to implement a given project properly.
- 4. Players' data may be published to allow other Players to read them. Photographs and film materials from the activities will also be made available on Instagram, Facebook, and the website www.dragonballskrakow.pl in a manner that is visible to athletes and third parties.
- 5. The data will be processed until the end of the Tournament for participation in which they were made available, and image data will be processed until their usefulness ceases.
- 6. Each Player has the right to access the data, correct it, withdraw consent at any time, request limitation of its processing, deletion and the right to be forgotten. Each time, you must submit any claims regarding your data electronically by sending an email to dragonballskrakow@gmail.com.
- 7. Providing personal data is voluntary but is a condition for participating in the Tournament.
- 8. Each person whose data is processed has the right to submit a complaint to the President of the Personal Data Protection Office.
- 9. The shared data will not be subject to profiling.

For situations and events not described in the Regulations of the Dragon Balls Kraków Cup Tournament, the provisions applicable to the country in which the activities of the Tournament Organiser are registered shall apply. The Organiser reserves the right to change the regulations if necessary.
